

Conditions of Entry

This event will run under EA/FEI rules. The Organising Committee (OC) reserves the right to change or amend the program at their discretion. All owners and competitors will be personally responsible for damages to any third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. Please ensure the safety of your children whilst in proximity to horses.

Codes of Conduct

The Technical Delegate (TD), Ground Jury, Officials, Boneo Park and Equestrian Australia (EA) are responsible for ensuring Horse Welfare guidelines are observed. Additionally, the above-mentioned groups are responsible for ensuring that the EA and the Boneo Park Codes of Conduct are adhered to at all times.

Scratching / Refunds of Entries

All scratchings prior to close of entries will be refunded in full less a \$20 administration fee. Once the entries have closed, no refunds will be given unless a veterinary or medical certificate is provided within seven days of the event. If a veterinary or medical certificate is supplied within the given timeframe 50% of entry fees paid will be refunded.

Refunds of Stables/yards/campsites

More than three days from the event, stable, yard and camping fees will be refunded in full less a \$20 administration fee. Within three days of the event, refunds, less the \$20 administration fee, will be given if the stable/yard/camp site can be filled.

No stable refund will occur once the event has started. For biosecurity, you must clear any stabling changes with the Event Secretary and/or stable manager.

Starts per horse

Horses may only start in a maximum of two classes per day.

Riders and Owners

All riders and owners must be current financial members of EA with no exception. All horses and ponies must hold current EA registration with the exception of those competing in classes 104cm and under.

EA age rules

Junior – Riders are considered Juniors, from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 12 until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 18 years old.

Young Rider – Riders are considered Young Riders from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 16 until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 21 years old.

Athletes may take part in open competitions 1.20m and above from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 12.

World Cup Qualifier

Horses in the World Cup Qualifier must hold FEI passports. Riders must have FEI registrations.

There will be an arrival inspection for World Cup Qualifier horses conducted by the FEI vet and steward. The arrival inspection will take place at your stable or yard on Saturday 1st February, it is here that passports will be checked. A trot up for all World Cup Qualifier horses will then take place midafternoon on Saturday 1st February - exact time and location TBC. After the arrival inspection all World Cup Qualifier horses must stay on site until the conclusion of the competition.

Future Stars

The Future Stars class is for Horses aged 6, 7, 8 or 9 years old at the time of the competition. Horses must have 50 points or less at close of entries.

Off the Track Championship

Effective from 1 August 2018, any horse bred to race that has been Stud Book-registered, either domestically with the Australian Stud Book or internationally, will be eligible to compete in Off The Track events in Victoria. Racing name and microchip number must be provided with entry.

Champion of Champions

The best performed combination from the Boneo Classic and the World Wetlands Day World Cup Jumping will be awarded in the following classes:

- World Cup \$1000
- Mini Prix \$500
- Futurity \$500
- Young Rider \$250
- Junior \$250

To be eligible for the Champion of Champions prize combinations must compete at both the Boneo Classic and the World Wetlands Day World Cup shows in the same class (ie compete in the World Cup class at both shows).

The winner will be determined by the combination with the best placings from both shows. In the event of equal placings the winner will be the combination with the least faults from both shows. If they are still equal then the winner will be the combination with the least time taken from the final round of competition from both shows.

Dress Code

Riders in all competition rings must be in correct dress unless otherwise instructed by the judge. It is compulsory for athletes to wear a properly fastened safety approved helmet at all times whilst mounted. The only exception to this is athletes over the age of 18 may remove their helmet at the presentation in the competition arena only.

Presentations

Presentations will be mounted, and riders must wear their correct attire.

Dogs

Dogs must be kept on a leash and under effective control at all times. Dogs are not permitted in warm up or competition areas.

Early entry packages

Early entry packages are available for \$550 (inc. GST). With this package you are guaranteed up to five permanent stables or yards, close camping and access to enter before the opening date. Please note you must book and pay for stables, yards and camping with your entries. This offer applies to both the Boneo Classic and the World Wetlands Day World Cup Jumping events.
