- Combined training will run under the current EA National Eventing Rules
- Horse / rider combinations are permitted to compete in one combined training class only
 - The same horse and rider must compete in both dressage and jumping
- No whips allowed in the dressage, whips up to 75cm allowed in the jumping phase, with the exception of Primary 35 where a whip up to 75cm may be used for dressage phase
- No calling of dressage tests, with the exception of Primary 35 where tests may be called

- Dressage tests will be run under the current EA dressage rules
- If a horse / rider combination is entering the combined training, they may enter one additional dressage test
- If a horse / rider combination is not entering combined training, they may enter two additional dressage tests at consecutive levels (ie prelim and novice)
 - Whips are permitted up to 100 cm for ponies and 120 cm for horses
 - Tests may be called

GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS

- All dressage tests are ridden in a 60m x 20m arena
 - Primary classes are open to all students currently in primary school (prep to year 6)
 - Secondary classes are open to all students currently enrolled in secondary school.
- Intermediate classes are for students in year 7, 8 and 9. Senior classes are for students in year 10, 11 and 12.
- Elementary, Medium and Advanced dressage classes are open to primary and secondary students.
 - Primary CT35 and Primary Prep dressage are for children in the early years of primary school and are inexperienced riders. Please do not enter these classes if the rider is graded higher than PCAV 5 or over 10 years of age.
 - Secondary CT45 is for secondary school students who are beginner riders. Any rider who has competed higher than preliminary dressage or jumped higher than 60cm on any horse must not enter this class.
 - All riders must be accompanied by an adult.
 - No riders other than those competing are allowed to ride at the equestrian centre.
 - One rider per horse rule applies.
 - All riders must wear approved helmets and boots at all times whilst mounted.
 - Full school equestrian uniform must be worn.
 - Schools are responsible for gear check.
 - Riders to provide own bridle / saddle number.
 - Refund Policy - Prior to closing date of entries, a refund will be given less a \$20 admin fee. After entries close no refunds will be paid unless a vet or medical certificate is provided. If a vet or medical certificate is provided within seven days of the event a 50% refund will be given.
 - If any event has to be cancelled, prior to it commencing, due to extreme weather or any other unforeseen reasons, entry fees will be refunded less \$20 admin fee to cover costs already incurred by the organising committee. If the event has to be cancelled after it has commenced, there will be no refunds.
 - Dogs are allowed and must be leashed at all times.

Series rules and conditions

- After each competition series points are allocated as follows 1st place 20 points, 2nd place 19 points and so on. If there are more than 20 in the class, those placing lower will not receive any points.
- After each competition series points are allocated to each school. The points from the four highest placed riders from each school will count. If a school has four riders winning four classes, they will get the maximum score of 80 points.
- To be eligible for the series prize, the combination must compete in at least two individual events, with the top three scores to count. You may compete at different levels however, points do not carry from one level to another.
- In the event of equal places for the series, the winner will be determined by the competitor with the least show jumping penalties. If they are still equal, then the highest aggregate dressage percentage of all tests will be the winner.
