



Dear Competitors,

Welcome to the 2020 December Christmas Dressage Competition, to be held Friday and Saturday 4th & 5th December.

We are so excited to welcome you all back to Boneo Park for our monthly dressage competition. To ensure we are operating within a Covid safe environment please note the following:

- Every person attending Boneo Park must register their attendance via our QR code registration system
- Social distance of 1.5 metres must be maintained
- Masks to be worn by everyone 12 years old and over when inside or where you cannot socially distance, eg at our cafe.
- There are no formal presentations. Rosettes and prizes may be collected from the event office (self-serve)
- Yards and stables must be booked. If you don't book a yard or stable you must tie up to the float and keep away from the yards and stable area.
- You must park at least four metres from the vehicle next to you.
- Yards and stables between groups must be left empty.
- Only one person permitted in wash bays at any one time
- Camping is permitted. Everyone attending is encouraged to download and use the CovidSafe app
- No one is to travel from a restricted area
- If you are unwell do not attend Boneo Park.
- If you are waiting on a Covid test result do not attend Boneo Park.
- Competitors are asked to "get in, compete, and get out".

Each person visiting Boneo Park understands and complies with the following:

I acknowledge the contagious nature of the Coronavirus/COVID-19 and that the Australian government and health authorities still recommend practicing social distancing. I further acknowledge that Boneo Park can not guarantee that I will not become infected with the Coronavirus/Covid-19. I understand that the risk of becoming exposed to and/or infected by the Coronavirus/COVID-19 may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of myself and others, including, but not limited to, staff, and other riders and their families.

I acknowledge that I must comply with all set procedures to reduce the spread while attending Boneo Park. I attest that:

- I am not experiencing any symptom of illness such as cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fever, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell.
- I have not returned home from international travel within the last 14 days.
- I do not believe I have been exposed to someone with a suspected and/or confirmed case of the Coronavirus/COVID-19.
- I have not been diagnosed with Coronavirus/Covid-19 and not yet cleared as non contagious health authorities.

- I am following all recommended guidelines as much as possible and limiting my exposure to the Coronavirus/COVID-19.

Other information:

All riders must sign a disclaimer before riding at Boneo Park, if they have not done so before. These can be found at the event office.

All stables are numbered and stable allocation lists can be found on each aisle. The list will also be placed on the Boneo Park website prior to the competition - please check the list again when you arrive to ensure there have been no changes. All stables have fresh sawdust already in them. Please place any muck from your stables in the designated muck heap behind the stable complex.

3 wash bays are located in the north aisle of the stables, please feel free to use.

Please note only agistees are permitted in the indoor arena stable block.

Arena Familiarisation:

Outdoor Arenas:

Thursday - Outdoor 1 and 2: 2.00pm - 6.00pm

Thursday - Outdoor 3-6: 1.00pm - 6.00pm

Friday morning: Around edges only until 8am (please note that arena grading will also take place at this time)

Friday Afternoon: at completion of competition until 6.00pm

Saturday Morning: Around edges only until 8am (please note that arena grading will also take place at this time)

Please only lunge in the round yard, not on the arenas. Please note that only horses competing are allowed in warm up arenas while competition is taking place.

Check in: Due to Covid 19 there is no check in. Please report directly to your ring marshall.

Parking If you have not booked a yard or stable please park on the grass area on the far side of Barn 2. You will need to tie up to your float. If you have booked a

yard you can park directly in front of your yard. Stabled horses please unload in the driveway and park on the campsites. Please do not park in campsites that have been allocated to other people.

Yards: Will be named for those that have reserved and booked. Due to Covid 19 if you have not booked a yard you must not use a yard.

Presentations: There will be no formal presentations, all place-getters can pick up their rosettes and prizes from the event office.

Toilets: Are located in the Rider's Retreat Complex, North end of Stable Barn 2 and in the restaurant precinct.

Bridle Numbers: As per EA rules horses must wear bridle numbers at all times while on the venue including while being led.

EA Registration Papers: As per EA rules, Horse and Rider EA registration papers must be available on request at the competition.

Dogs: Must be kept on a lead and are not permitted in the stables, arenas or warm up areas. Dogs are not permitted in the Rider's Retreat or Indoor complex. Please ensure you stick to these guidelines and ensure your family and friends do also.

Draw: Due to large entries being received times may change as a move up system will apply in the event of scratchings, please check the final draw which will be posted the evening prior to competition.
