## Special Information relating to Young Horse and Pony Competitions

Entry fees for the Young Horse and Pony include both rounds

To be run under the State Championships formula

Both rounds may be used as qualifiers

Callers are permitted

All horses, riders and owners must be current members and registered with the EA. EA Rules apply. All horses must exceed 149 cms with shoes.

Birth dates for all horses will be as at 1st August and birth date must be indicated on entry form

4 YO Championship for Horses/Ponies—open to Horses/Ponies born between 1-8-2017 and 31-7-2018

5 YO Championship for Horses/Ponies—open to Horses/ Ponies born between 1-8-2016 and 31-7-2017

6 YO Championship for Horses/Ponies—open to Horses/Ponies born between 1-8-2015 and 31-7-2016

7 YO Championship for Horses —open to Horses born between 1-8-2014 and 31-7-2015

All horses and ponies to be ridden in snaffle bridle with the exception of 7YO horses who may be ridden in either a snaffle or double bridle.

All ponies must hold current EA registration and must provide an EA approved height certificate.

**Approved safety helmets are to be worn for all Young Horse/Pony competitions.**

Whips are permitted to be carried in all age group.

### **Dressage Tests and format**

#### **Round 1: Commanded in groups of 2 for 4/5/6 year old classes**

o EA YH commanded tests for 4/5/6 yr old horses (same test for both horses and ponies).  
7YO Round 1 test is the 7yo technical test and will be ridden individually

#### **Round 2: Ridden individually**

Tests to be ridden will be:

- o 4-Year-Old Horses & Ponies: FEI test for 4 year old horses;
- o 5 Year-Old-Horses & Ponies: FEI YH Preliminary test for 5 year old horses;
- o 6 Year-Old-Horses: FEI YH Preliminary test for 6 year old horses;
- o 6 Year-Old-Ponies: EA Young Pony Preliminary test for 6 year olds
- 7 Year-Old-Horses: FEI YH Preliminary test for 7 year old horses

**The mark from the second round will determine the final placings**

### **Conditions and General Information - CDI & CDN Competitors**

The Boneo Summer Dressage Championships will be conducted in strict accordance with the current edition (including amendments) of: *FEI General Regulations; FEI Veterinary Regulations & FEI Dressage Rules* and 2022 Equestrian Australia Dressage Rules.

### **COVID-19**

The event schedule is subject to change based on the regulations that will apply at the time of the event. All competitors, grooms, owners, officials and visitors must adhere to the current Victorian Government and Equestrian Victoria COVID restrictions and regulations that apply during this event. More information will be provided to competitors closer to the event. All participants and visitors to the venue will need sign in using the venue's QR code to gain admission to the venue

### **ELIGIBILITY AND ACCEPTANCE**

All horses and riders must be EA members.

A maximum of 35 combinations will be accepted at each level. For classes which don't require performance qualification, entries will be accepted on a first come first served basis until the class is fully subscribed. Subsequent entries will be placed on a reserve list.

*Please note that as a result of the limited number of competitions in Australia during the past twelve months the EADC have granted an exemption to the normal performance requirements for CDI sanctioned events. The following eligibility will apply for the 2022 Boneo Summer Dressage Championships:*

**CDN-P:** Open to riders from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 12 until the end of the calendar year they reach the age of 16. Ponies must be at least 6 years of age and must not exceed 148cm without shoes. No performances required.

**CDN Grand Prix** The combination must be eligible to compete at Grand Prix level under rule 4.8.3.2. One performance of 60% in a Grand Prix test is required in the previous twelve months.

**CDI-3\* Grand Prix** Two performances of at least 63% at Grand Prix level in the previous two years.

**CDI-J:** Open to riders from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 14 until the end of the calendar year they reach the age of 18. Horses must be at least 6 years of age. One performance of 60% at medium or above level is required in the previous twelve months.

**CDI-Y:** Open to riders from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 16 until the end of the calendar year they reach the age of 21. Horses must be at least 7 years of age. The combination must be eligible to compete at this level under rule 4.8.3.2 and one performance of 60% at PSG or above level is required in the previous twelve months.

**CDI-U25:** Open to riders from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 16 until the end of the calendar year they reach the age of 25. The combination must have achieved at least one performance of 60% in Intermediate A or Intermediate B, or Intermediate II or Grand Prix tests in the previous twelve months.

**Para-Equestrian:** Open to all FEI registered para equestrian riders, riders may compete from the beginning of the year in which they reach the age of 14.

**Small Tour, Medium Tour & Intermediate II CDN:** No performances required however riders must be eligible to compete at the level as per EA rule 4.8.3.2.

**EA Preliminary – Advanced Championship and Young Horse/Pony Classes:** No performances required

*The Organising Committee does have discretion to make exceptions in special circumstances to accept certain combinations in consultation with the EADC and Selectors.*

### **Freestyles**

**CDN Intermediate I Freestyle** – Open to the top 10 placegetters, who received a minimum score of 58%, in the Intermediate I competition.

**CDI\*\*\* Grand Prix Freestyle** – A horse must obtain a minimum score of 60% in the qualifying Grand Prix CDI competition to be eligible to start in the Freestyle competition. Limited to 15 horses. A rider may start only one (1) horse unless entries are below 15 horses and approved by the FEI.

**CDI-U25 Freestyle:** Open to horses that obtain a minimum score of 60% in the U25 GP. It is compulsory for riders to enter and take part in the U25 freestyle should they qualify in the U25 GP. A rider may start only one (1) horse.

CDI-Y: Open to horses that obtain a minimum score of 60% in the CDI-Y Individual competition. A rider may start only one (1) horse. A maximum of 8 horses will be accepted.

CDI-J: Open to horses that obtain a minimum score of 60% in the CDI-J Individual competition. A rider may start only one (1) horse. A maximum of 8 horses will be accepted.

### CDI Entry Requirements

Riders may participate under the jurisdiction of the country of which the rider holds his/her passport  
Riders may ride more than one horse as per the FEI Schedule.

Riders should be aware that the FEI considers any withdrawals without a valid excuse after the definite entry date as serious.

**All horses entered for a CDI whether at home or in foreign countries, must have an official FEI Passport, or National Passport approved by the FEI, as a means of identification and to establish ownership. (Gen. Regs. Art. 137). EA Horse I.D. documents are available from the EA National Office. Riders must ensure that they have the appropriate documents on arrival. Enquiries EA 02 8762 7777.**

All riders and horses participating in FEI events (at this event all CDI classes) must be registered on the FEI database. Registrations must be renewed each calendar year. EA collects the charges on behalf of the FEI. Registration forms are available on the EA web site. [www.equestrian.org.au](http://www.equestrian.org.au) or contact the National Office. Please note that this registration is required even if the horse has an FEI Passport or EA National Identification Document.

Advertising and Publicity on competitors and horses (Gen. Regs. Art. 135.1-2): The competitors are authorised to carry the logo of their personal sponsor on the saddle cloth in accordance with Art. 135.1-2. Riders with privately organised sponsorship may display a "logo" of their sponsor on their saddlecloth. The area covered by this logo may not exceed 200 sq. cm. A sponsor's label on jackets must not exceed 80 sq. cm at the height of breast pockets. Please note that if more than one sponsor logo is placed on the saddlecloth, the area covered by all logos may not exceed 200 sq. cm as above. The Chief Steward will check that the advertising and publicity on competitors and horses complies with Article 135 of the General Regulations.

Liability: Riders and/or owners whose entries have been accepted will undertake to indemnify the Organizing Body against all claims, losses, suits, and damages made against or suffered by the Organizing Body by reason of any negligent act or omission on the part of any rider, trainer or attendant whilst he is attending, riding or otherwise handling a horse and agrees that act or omission on the part of such rider or attendant found in any action against the Organizing Body to be negligent, shall be deemed to have been negligent for the purpose of any claim under this indemnity.

Entry refunds: Prior to the close of entries a full refund less the administration fee will be given for scratchings. After the close of entries, 50% of the entry fee will be refunded on receipt of a doctor's or vet certificate submitted to Event Secretary, 312 Boneo Road, Boneo, VIC 3939 within 7 days of the event. ## THE FEI CODE OF CONDUCT

Sampling procedure for Prohibited substances – FEI Vet Regs, Chapter V & VI and Annex III. Horses will be subject to sampling for Prohibited Substances.

### **FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE**

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
2. Horses and athletes must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
5. **The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.**

## BONEO PARK CODE OF CONDUCT

The Boneo Park Equestrian Centre is an exclusive, private facility and in the interests of ensuring the enjoyment and safety of all users the following code of conduct applies. Management at Boneo Park can use discretion at any point in time to determine access to the facilities and are not limited to the code below.

**Insurance:** All owners and competitors are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. They are therefore strongly advised to take out a third-party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events at home and abroad, and to keep the policy up to date.

### Each person visiting Boneo Park understands and complies with the following:

I acknowledge the contagious nature of the Coronavirus/COVID-19 and that the Australian government and health authorities still recommend practicing social distancing. I further acknowledge that Boneo Park can not guarantee that I will not become infected with the Coronavirus/Covid-19. I understand that the risk of becoming exposed to and/or infected by the Coronavirus/COVID-19 may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of myself and others, including, but not limited to, staff, and other riders and their families.

I acknowledge that I must comply with all set procedures to reduce the spread while attending Boneo Park. I attest that:

- I am not experiencing any symptom of illness such as cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fever, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell.
- I have not returned home from international travel within the last 14 days.
- I do not believe I have been exposed to someone with a suspected and/or confirmed case of the Coronavirus/COVID-19.
- I have not been diagnosed with Coronavirus/Covid-19 and not yet cleared as non contagious health authorities.
- I am following all recommended guidelines as much as possible and limiting my exposure to the Coronavirus/COVID-19.

## Personal Conduct

A person must not do any of the following whilst at Boneo Park:

- use indecent, obscene, insulting or threatening language
- behave in an offensive or indecent manner
- cause serious alarm or affront to a person by disorderly or unsafe conduct
- obstruct a person in the performance of that person's work or duties
- Boneo Park management do not tolerate the use, transfer or possession of illegal drugs on the premises. Anyone found using, transferring or in possession of any non-prescribed illegal drug will be ejected and may be handed over to the police.

## Riding Conduct

- Approved AS/ NZ 3838 safety helmets must be worn at all times when riding
- The FEI Code of Conduct for the Welfare of the Horse must be abided by at all times
- Smooth soled and heeled boots are worn.
- Riding of unsaddled or unbridled horses is prohibited
- Arena etiquette is observed including:
  - Left hand to left hand
  - Walking give right of way
  - Diagonal changes have right of way
- Uncontrolled horses are removed from the arena

- Horses must be led along laneways not the main drive
- Cars and vehicles are not allowed on horse laneways
- Please be aware that all fences are electric.
