Withdrawals/ Scratchings

Prior to 7.30am Friday 28th January, please email all scratchings to events@boneopark.com.au. Once the show is underway, we ask that all scratchings are notified to the event office by 3pm the day prior to the competition to ensure accurate draws can be done.



Draw Order

All rings will run in draw order with the priority given to Ring 2. If riders think they will have a clash in ring 1, 3 or 4 they must notify the judge prior to the commencement of the class. Rings will not wait for riders in the first round or the jump off.

Late Entries/class changes

Once the show is underway late entries and class changes will be accepted if there is room in the class. All late entries will include a \$10 fee.

Course Walk

Course walk will commence half an hour before the published start time of each ring.

Exercise Arenas

Warm up arenas A and B will be open to ride on until the beginning of competition on Friday. The back-grass arena will be open to use also for the duration of the event.

Prize Money

Prize money will be presented at the arena with the exception of first, second and third for classes over 105cm. This prizemoney can be collected from the event office and cards must be shown. EA horse and rider number will be recorded for EA purposes.

Onsite

Stables/ Yards

Due to the many changes stable and yard allocation will be posted online and updated regularly, please check the allocation list upon arrival.

NOTE: Please bring your own feeds, shovel, water buckets etc. Sawdust bedding will be supplied for all days of stabling. Stables will be cleaned for you after departure. Top up sawdust is available from the sawdust pile throughout the event.

Day Parking

Riders who have not booked a stable or yard must park in the day parking area and tie up to the float.

Camping

Campsites will be allocated, please camp in your allocated site. Please do not park in someone else's campsite. Any cars, floats or trucks who have not booked a campsite will be removed. Please note, no horses are allowed in the campsite area.

Dogs

Dogs are welcome at Boneo Park but must be kept on a lead and away from stables and competition arenas.

Restaurant Car Parking


Restaurant patrons please drive all the way down the driveway past the stables to the restaurant car park.

Getting to Boneo Park

312 Boneo Road, Boneo.

Google Maps:

1. Take Eastlink from Melbourne
2. Merge left onto the Peninsula Link following signs to Portsea
3. Continue following the Peninsula Link and it will run into the Mornington Peninsula Freeway
4. Follow this all the way to the end
5. At the last roundabout when you cannot go any further turn left onto Boneo Road.
6. Take the turning lane on the right after Bunnings into Boneo Park.



On arrival

Proceed to horse unloading zone in front of stable blocks. After unloading please move your vehicle to your designated camp site or to the car/float parking area.

Welfare

Welfare of the horse- FEI CODE OF CONDUCT

1. The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.
2. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery, tack, and transportation.
3. Horses and competitors must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
4. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
5. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
 - a) The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.
