

TROT UP/HORSE INSPECTION GUIDELINES

Refer for further information: FEI Veterinary Regulations, Art. 1033 and the FEI Stewards Manual

- All handlers 25 years of age and under must wear a helmet while presenting their horse
- The person responsible should present the horse unless prior permission to have a substitute lead the horse has been granted by the chief FEI steward.
- Horses can be presented in either a snaffle or double bridle
- Horses must wear bridle numbers on both sides of bridle
- Handlers should be neatly dressed with suitable shoes for running
- No rugs or bandages on horses and no dye or paint on horses or hooves, clear hoof polish is acceptable
- A short whip may be carried by the handler on approval of the Inspection panel.
