Show Jumping Class Definitions

All Classes:

"A2" ARTICLE 238.2.1

Table A class over one round against the clock. Riders jump all obstacles. Placings are according to clean round and time taken.

"GRAND PRIX" ARTICLE 273.3.3.1

COMPETITION OVER TWO ROUNDS 1. This Competition comprises, with the same speed, two courses, identical or different, either in track or in number of obstacles or in the dimensions of the obstacles. Each Athlete must participate with the same Horse. Athletes, who have been eliminated or who have retired during the first round, may not take part in the second round and may not be placed. All the Athletes go forward to the second round according to the conditions of this schedule. The second round is in reverse order of penalties in the 1st round; Athletes retain their drawn order in case of equality of penalties there is no jump-off.

GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS

- This competition is open to all students currently enrolled in primary, secondary or home school students.
- *Freshman class is open to all students currently enrolled in primary school (prep to year 6).
- Secondary students may ride in Freshman section HC (ie they do not compete for a prize and no points awarded to school)
- With the exception of Freshmans, classes are open to all students.
- All riders must be accompanied by an adult.
- No riders other than those competing are allowed to ride at the equestrian centre.
- One rider per horse rule applies.
- Riders may ride more than one horse.

- All riders must wear approved helmets and boots at all times whilst mounted.
- Full school equestrian uniform must be worn
- Schools are responsible for gear check
- Riders to provide own bridle / saddle number
- Refund Policy Prior to the closing date of entries, a refund will be given less an admin fee of \$20.
 After entries close no refunds unless a vet or medical certificate is provided. If a vet or medical certificate is provided within seven days of the event a 50% refund will be given. If any event has to be cancelled, prior to it commencing, due to extreme weather or any other unforeseen reasons, entry fees will be refunded less \$20 admin fee to cover costs already incurred by the organising committee. If the event has to be cancelled after it has commenced, there will be no refunds.
- Dogs allowed, but must be leashed at all times.

Individual prizes, School and Series rules and conditions:

- Ribbon will be awarded to 6th place in each competition (with the exception of secondary freshmans)
- Champion and Reserve rosettes awarded for each class
- Points will be allocated in the "A2" class: 35 for first, 34 for second, 33 for third and so on down to one point for 35th.
- Points will be allocated in the "Grand Prix" class: 35 for first, 34 for second, 33 for third and so on down to one point for 35th.
- Points scored from each class will be aggregated to determine the Champions and Reserve.
- In the case of equality of points, the rider with the higher points from the Grand Prix will be the winner.
- Points scored from each event will be carried across the three competitions to determine the series winner. The series winner will be awarded a rug.
- The best four scores will be taken from each school
- Points for the school are 10 given to the Champions, down to 1 for 10th place overall.
- In the case of equality for the school or series, the aggregate of the Grand Prix scores will be used.

Round 1 is the VEIS qualifier. Please also refer to the VEIS rules and conditions.
