Conditions of Entry

Note: Ring 1 classes are limited to protect the grass arena for the Australian Jumping Championships. Numbers in these classes will be restricted, with priority given to those entering National Championships classes.

This event will run under EA rules and regulations. The Organising Committee (OC) reserves the right to change or amend the program at their discretion. All owners and competitors will be personally responsible for damages to any third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. Please ensure the safety of your children whilst in proximity to horses.

Codes of Conduct

The Event Director, Ground Jury, Officials, Boneo Park and Equestrian Australia (EA) are responsible for ensuring Horse Welfare guidelines are observed. Additionally, the above-mentioned groups are responsible for ensuring that the EA and the Boneo Park Codes of Conduct are adhered to at all times.

General Regs Article 116.11 - The OC may at their absolute discretion and shall, if they consider it expedient to do so, decline to receive any entry or return any fee without being liable for any compensation.

Scratching / Refunds of Entries

All scratchings prior to close of entries will be refunded in full less a \$50 administration fee. Once the entries have closed, no refunds will be given unless a veterinary or medical certificate is provided within seven days of the event. If a veterinary or medical certificate is supplied within the given timeframe 50% of entry fees paid will be refunded. Scratchings must be emailed to events@boneopark.com.au

Refunds of Stables/yards/campsites

More than seven days from the event, stable, yard and camping fees will be refunded in full less a \$50 administration fee. Within seven days of the event, refunds, less the \$50 administration fee, will be given if the stable/yard/camp site can be filled. No stable refund will occur once the event has started. For biosecurity, you must clear any stabling changes with the Event Secretary and/or stable manager.

Cancellation of event / class

If Boneo Park cancels the event due to Covid-19, extreme weather conditions, low numbers or other unforeseen circumstances, Boneo Park reserves the right to retain a \$50 administration fee per rider. All other money paid will be refunded. There will be no refunds once the event has started. If Boneo Park cancels a class due to extreme weather conditions, low numbers or other unforeseen circumstances, the entry fee will be refunded.





Starts per horse

Horses may only start in a maximum of two classes per day.

Combinations may only enter Children's or Junior or Young Rider. Combinations may only enter Future Stars or Mini Prix or Arilla Cup.

Riders and Owners

All riders and owners must be current financial members of EA with no exception. All horses and ponies must hold current EA registration and jumping licenses, with the exception of those competing in classes 104cm and under. Entry checks will be undertaken.

EA age rules

The following EA age rules apply:

- Children Riders are considered Children until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 14 years old,
- Junior Riders are considered Juniors, from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 12 until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 18 years old.
- Young Rider Riders are considered Young Riders from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 16 until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 21 years old.
- Open height Athletes may take part in open competitions 1.20m and above from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 12.

Future Stars

The Future Stars class is for Horses aged 6, 7, 8 or 9 years old at the time of the competition. Horses must have less than 50 points at close of entries.

Young Horse Class

Four year old class - Horses must be 4 years old on 28 October 2022, based on the horse birth date.

Five year old class - Horses must be 5 years old on 28 October 2022, based on the horse birth date.

Six year old class - Horses must be 6 years old on 28 October 2022, based on the horse birth date.

Concurrent classes

Class with an A and B are running concurrently. You may only enter one of these classes, not both.



Off the Track Championship

Effective from 1 August 2018, any horse bred to race that has been Stud Book-registered, either domestically with the Australian Stud Book or internationally, will be eligible to compete in Off the Track events in Victoria. Racing name and microchip number must be provided with entry. Entry checks will be undertaken.

Dress Code

Riders in all competition rings must be in correct dress unless otherwise instructed by the judge. It is compulsory for athletes to wear a properly fastened safety approved helmet at all times whilst mounted. The only exception to this is athletes over the age of 18 may remove their helmet at the presentation in the competition arena only. Helmets must be tagged.

Presentations

Presentations will be mounted, and riders must wear their correct attire.

Catering

Arilla Restaurant will be open throughout the event. We recommend booking in advance to avoid disappointment. Bookings and further details at <u>www.boneopark.com/restaurant</u> The Boneo Park café will be open throughout the event.

Stallions

The Organising Committee follows the EA Stallion Code of Conduct.

Dogs

Dogs must be kept on a leash and under effective control at all times. Dogs are not permitted in warm up or competition areas.

- Facility fee \$30 per horse
- Late fee \$10 per class
