



2022/2023 Racing Victoria Off The Track (OTT) Dressage Series

To be conducted at official EA Boneo Park dressage events including the December, January and March Events at Preliminary and Novice Level. Two tests at each level, on each competition day, will be offered. As well as competing in the open classes, OTT horses will also be eligible for separate placings against other OTT horses as well as in the overall series leaderboard.

For the series leaderboard the three best percentage scores will count for each combination. The rider with the highest three scores will be the winner of the series.

A leaderboard will be kept by Boneo Park and posted on our website with the winner, second and third at the end of the year awarded at each level to the following value:

Preliminary - 1st \$2000 and rug, 2nd - \$1000, 3rd - \$500

Novice - 1st \$2000 and rug, 2nd - \$1000, 3rd \$500

At each competition day riders will also receive ribbons and prizes for the individual test results.

Conditions:

- Any horse bred to race that has been Stud Book-registered, either domestically with the Australian Stud Book or internationally is eligible to compete in OTT events in Victoria.
- Horses must be claimed on Racing Victoria's Off The Track Community www.ottcommunity.com.au
- Riders must submit the horse's racing/studbook name and microchip number for eligibility checking
- Riders and horses must be EA members with current dressage cards
- There is no minimum or maximum number of competitions that combinations must do to be eligible
- In the event of a tie the single highest % will be the winner
- No points will be awarded for any elimination or retired result
