Conditions of Entry

This event will run under EA rules and regulations. The Organising Committee (OC) reserves the right to change or amend the program at their discretion. All owners and competitors will be personally responsible for damages to any third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. Please ensure the safety of your children whilst in proximity to horses.

Codes of Conduct

The Event Director, Ground Jury, Officials, Boneo Park and Equestrian Australia (EA) are responsible for ensuring Horse Welfare guidelines are observed. Additionally, the abovementioned groups are responsible for ensuring that the EA and the Boneo Park Codes of Conduct are adhered to at all times.

General Regs Article 116.11 - The OC may at their absolute discretion and shall, if they consider it expedient to do so, decline to receive any entry or return any fee without being liable for any compensation.

Scratching / Refunds of Entries

All scratchings prior to close of entries will be refunded in full less a \$60 administration fee. Once the entries have closed, no refunds will be given unless a veterinary or medical certificate is provided within seven days of the event. If a veterinary or medical certificate is supplied within the given timeframe 50% of entry fees paid will be refunded. Scratchings must be emailed to events@boneopark.com.au

Refunds of Stables/yards/campsites

More than seven days from the event, stable, yard and camping fees will be refunded in full less a \$60 administration fee. Within seven days of the event, refunds, less the \$60 administration fee, will be given if the stable/yard/camp site can be filled. No stable refund will occur once the event has started. For biosecurity, you must clear any stabling changes with the Event Secretary and/or stable manager.

Cleaning of stables

Stables will be cleaned by Boneo Park upon your departure. Any stables left excessively dirty will incur an additional \$50 cleaning fee per stable. Boneo Park reserves the right to charge this to the credit card used to pay for entries. Excessively dirty includes manure not being removed during the event, wheelbarrows emptied into stables etc.



Cancellation of event / class

If Boneo Park cancels the event due to Covid-19, extreme weather conditions, low numbers or other unforeseen circumstances, Boneo Park reserves the right to retain a \$60 administration fee per rider. All other money paid will be refunded. There will be no refunds once the event has started. If Boneo Park cancels a class due to extreme weather conditions, low numbers or other unforeseen circumstances, the entry fee will be refunded.

Starts per horse

Horses may only start in a maximum of two classes per day.

Registration and licenses

All riders and owners must be current financial members of EA with no exception. All horses and ponies competing in classes over 105cm must hold current EA registration and jumping licenses. Horses and ponies competing in classes 104cm and under must hold a base registration. Entry checks will be undertaken.

Age restricted classes

The following EA age rules apply:

- Children Riders are considered Children until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 14 years old.
- Junior Riders are considered Juniors, from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 12 until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 18 years old.
- Young Rider Riders are considered Young Riders from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 16 until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 21 years old.
- Open height Athletes may take part in open competitions 1.20m and above from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 12.

Championship Classes

Combinations may only compete in one Championship class, with the exception of the Speed Championship. This includes Children's, Junior, Young Rider, Amateur, Future Stars, Mini Prix and Grand Prix.

Round 1 classes

Children's, Junior, Young Rider and Amateur have a Round 1 class. The Round 1 class and the Championship class will be held as stand-alone classes; however, the Round 1 class will be used to seed the draw for the Championship class. Anyone who doesn't start in Round 1 or is eliminated/retires may still start in the Championship but will be first to go. Both classes must be entered individually.



Future Stars

The Future Stars class is for horses that are 6, 7 or 8 years old at the time of the competition. There is no point restriction for this class.

Any Horse that has started in a World Cup Class cannot compete in the Future Stars class.

Amateur Championship

Riders may compete as amateurs from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 21 years of age. To compete as an Amateur rider, the following conditions must be met:

- Never competed in an Olympic Games or World Equestrian Games in either Jumping or Eventing
- In the past 10 years must not have competed in a World Cup for Jumping Riders qualifying round or in a 5* or 4* three-day event.
- In the past two years must not have competed in section 1 and 2 at a Royal Show in Sydney, Brisbane, Melbourne, Adelaide or Perth
- Amateur riders may not compete in an Amateur Class if they compete in a class higher than 1.20m at that show.
- Amateur riders may not compete in an Amateur Class on a horse that will compete in any class higher than 1.20m at that show.

Concurrent classes

Class with an A and B are running concurrently. You may only enter one of these classes, not both.

Off the Track Championship

February Jumping Championship is the first event in the 2024 Racing Victoria Off the Track Jumping series. There are three separate series being held over three competitions.

Class 19b is part of Series 1. The Off the Track Rising Star Jumping Series. The Rising Star Jumping Series classes are open to Australian Stud Book registered thoroughbreds that last raced or competed in an official trial within two years of the first Event date (i.e. must have still been active (not have retired) as at 23 February 2022).

Class 16c is part of Series 2. The Off the Track Jumping Series (Jump height 105-110cm maximum). Open to any horse bred to race that has been Stud Book-registered, either domestically with the Australian Stud Book or internationally.

Class 29b is part of Series 3. The Off the Track Jumping Series (Jump height 120-130cm maximum) Open to any horse bred to race that has been Stud Book-registered, either domestically with the Australian Stud Book or internationally.



Racing name and microchip number must be provided with entry. Horses must be claimed on the OTT community website. Entry checks will be undertaken. Full details of the series can be found on the Boneo Park website.

Dress Code

Riders in all competition rings must be in correct dress unless otherwise instructed by the judge. It is compulsory for athletes to wear a properly fastened safety approved helmet at all times whilst mounted. The only exception to this is athletes over the age of 18 may remove their helmet at the presentation in the competition arena only. Helmets must be tagged.

Presentations and Prize Money

Presentations will be mounted, and riders must wear their correct attire. Prize money will be paid in cash at the presentation. Failure to attend the presentation or send a stand in may result in money being forfeited.

Stallions

The Organising Committee follows the EA Stallion Code of Conduct.

Scooters

Helmets must be worn at all times whilst riding a scooter.

Scooters must only be ridden at 'walking pace' and are not to be ridden down the main Boneo Park driveway. Horses have right of way at all times and scooter users must take all reasonable steps to ensure they do not spook horses.

Dogs

Dogs must be kept on a leash and under effective control at all times. Dogs are not permitted in warm up or competition arenas.

Full Boneo Park code of conduct can be found on the Boneo Park website and must be adhered to at all times.



Extra charges including stabling, yards and camping:

Competitors are welcome to stay at Boneo Park following the GDP show. Bookings for stables, yards and camping are in blocks for the entire show. Prices includes all days between the GDP show and the February Championships.

Prices shown are for stays between Monday 19th February and Monday 26th February.

- Yards \$120 per yard
- Build your own yards \$75 per horse
- Camping powered \$150, unpowered \$120
