All stables are numbered and stable allocation lists can be found on the Boneo Park website prior to the competition – please check the list again when you arrive to ensure there have been no changes. All stables have fresh sawdust already in them. Please place any muck from your stables in the designated muck heap behind the stable complex.

3 wash bays are located in the north aisle of the stables, please feel free to use.

Please note only agistees are permitted in the indoor arena stable block

Please only lunge in the round yard, not on the arenas.

Parking Please park near the yards if you do not have a stable booked. Stabled horses please unload in the drive way and park on the campsites. Please keep off any fenced off areas and stay on the tracks. Please do not park in campsites that have been allocated to other people.

Yards: Will be named for those that have reserved and booked. Please do not park in front of yards that have names on them as these have been booked and paid for by other competitors. If you have not booked a yard or stable you need to tie up to the float.

Presentations: Will be held on the Restaurant deck at the conclusion of each class.

Toilets: A large block of toilets is located in the rider's retreat building, to the east of the stable complex. Toilets are also located at the restaurant complex.

Dogs: Must be kept on a lead and are not permitted in the stables, arenas or warm up areas. Dogs are not permitted in the Rider Retreat Café or Indoor complex. Please ensure you stick to these guidelines and ensure your family and friends do also.
