



## **2025 Racing Victoria Off The Track (OTT) Dressage Series**

To be conducted at official EA Boneo Park dressage events in January and March at Preliminary, Novice and Elementary Level. Two tests at each level, on each competition day, will be offered, (i.e 8 eligible tests in total over the series for each level.). OTT horses will also be eligible for championship prizemoney at each event as well as gaining points for the overall series leaderboard.

Riders will receive a percentage for each test as per the Equestrian Australia scoring system. For the series leaderboard the three best percentage scores will count for each combination. The combination with the highest three scores will be the winner of the series. A leaderboard will be kept by Boneo Park and posted on our website with the winner, second and third at the end of the year awarded at each level to the following value:

**Preliminary - \$1000 and rug, 2nd - \$500, 3rd - \$250**

**Novice - \$1000 and rug, 2nd - \$500, 3rd - \$250**

**Elementary - \$1000 and rug, 2nd - \$500, 3rd - \$250**

**\*\*\*\* FUTURE STAR BONUS** - \$500 will be awarded to the highest placed horse in the Preliminary series who is an Australian Stud book registered thoroughbred that last raced, competed in an official trial, or was purchased from an accredited retainer, within two years of the first Event date, ie must have still been active (not have retired) as at 17 January 2023.

At each competition day riders will also receive ribbons and prizes for the individual test results as well as prizemoney for the overall Championship (across two tests) at each level on each of the four days to the value of:

**Championship Prizemoney at each level on each day: 1st - \$150, 2nd - \$100, 3rd - \$50**

### **Conditions:**

- Any horse bred to race that has been Stud Book-registered, either domestically with the Australian Stud Book or internationally is eligible to compete in OTT events in Victoria.
- Horses must be claimed on Racing Victoria's Off The Track Community [www.ottcommunity.com.au](http://www.ottcommunity.com.au)
- Riders must submit the horse's racing/studbook name and microchip number for eligibility checking
- Riders and horses must be EA members with current dressage cards

- There is no minimum or maximum number of competitions that combinations must do to be eligible
- In the event of a tie the single highest % will be the winner
- No points will be awarded for any elimination or retired result
