



## 2025 Racing Victoria Off The Track (OTT) Jumping Series

### **Eligible Events:**

Boneo Park March Monthly Jumping, 15-16, March 2025

Boneo Park April Monthly Jumping, 5-6, April 2025

Boneo Park May Monthly Jumping, 3-4 May 2025

### **Series 1. The OTT Rising Star Jumping Series (Jump height starting 70cm, maximum height 80cm)**

The Rising Star Jumping Series classes are open to Australian Stud Book registered thoroughbreds that last raced or competed in an official trial within two years of the first Event date (i.e. must have still been active (not have retired) as at 15 March 2023). Jump height to be a maximum of 80cm for the final Event in May.

One class will be held on each day of each event (a total of six classes across the series of three events). Horses will receive points for their placing in each class. Points will be received for placegetters 1st - 10th (10 points for 1st, 9 points for 2nd and so on).

The horse and rider combination with the highest number of points throughout the series at the end of the three events is the winner.

In the case of equal placings, the combination with the least number of faults, and then the quickest cumulative time, (if there remains an equal placing after assessment of faults) would be announced the winner.

**Ribbons to 6th place in each class. Please note that combinations are also eligible for the ribbons and prizes for the open class too**

**Event prizemoney: \$500 (1st \$250, 2nd \$150, 3rd \$100) for each of the three events based on the aggregate performance of the Saturday and Sunday class. This will be available at the event office at the conclusion of the Sunday class.**

**Overall series prizemoney: 1st - \$1,000 and rug, 2nd - \$700, 3rd - \$300.**

**Series 2. The Off The Track Jumping Series  
(Jump height 100-110cm maximum)**

Open to any horse bred to race that has been Stud Book-registered, either domestically with the Australian Stud Book or internationally.

One class will be held on each day of each event (a total of six classes across the series of three events). Horses will receive points for their placing in each class. Points will be received for placegetters 1st - 10th (10 points for 1st, 9 points for 2nd and so on).

The horse and rider combination with the highest number of points throughout the series at the end of the three events is the winner.

In the case of equal placings, the combination with the least number of faults, and then the quickest cumulative time, (if there remains an equal placing after assessment of faults) would be announced the winner.

**Ribbons to 6th place in each class. Please note that combinations are also eligible for the ribbons and prizes for the open class too**

**Event prizemoney: \$500 (1st \$250, 2nd \$150, 3rd \$100) for each of the three events based on the aggregate performance of the Saturday and Sunday class. This will be available at the event office at the conclusion of the Sunday class.**

**Overall series prizemoney: 1st - \$1,000 and rug, 2nd - \$700, 3rd - \$300.**

**Series 3. The Off The Track Jumping Series  
(Jump height 115-125cm maximum)**

Open to any horse bred to race that has been Stud Book-registered, either domestically with the Australian Stud Book or internationally.

One class will be held on each day of each event (a total of six classes across the series of three events). Horses will receive points for their placing in each class. Points will be received for placegetters 1st - 10th (10 points for 1st, 9 points for 2nd and so on).

The horse and rider combination with the highest number of points throughout the series at the end of the three events is the winner.

In the case of equal placings, the combination with the least number of faults, and then the quickest cumulative time, (if there remains an equal placing after assessment of faults) would be announced the winner.

**Ribbons to 6th place in each class. Please note that combinations are also eligible for the ribbons and prizes for the open class too**

**Event prizemoney: \$500 (1st \$250, 2nd \$150, 3rd \$100) for each of the three events based on the aggregate performance of the Saturday and Sunday class. This will be available at the event office at the conclusion of the Sunday class.**

**Overall series prizemoney: 1st - \$1,000 and rug, 2nd - \$700, 3rd - \$300.**

**Conditions for all series entrants:**

- Riders must submit their horse's racing/studbook name and microchip number for eligibility checking to Boneo Park.
- Horses must be claimed on Racing Victoria's Off The Track Community [www.ottcommunity.com.au](http://www.ottcommunity.com.au)
- Horses are only eligible to compete in one series
- Points will be awarded to each horse/rider combination. If a horse's rider changes during the series then the new rider will not accumulate points from the previous rider.
- There is no minimum or maximum number of competitions that combinations must do to be eligible
- No points will be awarded for any elimination or retired result
